**ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS**

- The student must be a permanent resident of the State of Odisha.
- The income of the parents of the student from all sources should not exceed Rs.600000/- (Six lakh) only per annum.
- The student must have secured minimum 60% marks in the last qualifying examination (High School Certificate Examination) for applying scholarship.
- Students shall apply for Junior Merit Scholarship in the First year of joining (1st yr. of the course undertaken i.e. Class XI for fresh & in the second year i.e. Class XII for renewal).

**DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED**

- Resident certificate issued by the competent authority i.e. Tahasildar/Addl. Tahasildar.
- Proof of Annual Income issued by the competent authority i.e. the Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahasildar or Addl. Tahasildar.
- Mark sheets and Certificate of last qualifying examination (i.e. HSC).
- Bank Account details of the student concerned (First page of bank account containing account number and IFSC)
- ID card issued by the HSS. In absence of the same, the student may provide Admission receipt/Library card/Letter of undertaking from concerned HSS authority (any one).
- Aadhaar card of the applicant.

**IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS**

- Students are advised to go through the Guideline, "Bank accounts related advisory" and FAQs in the State Scholarship Portal (<https://scholarship.odisha.gov.in/website/home>) carefully before submission of application and keep applicant's copy for future reference.
- Eligible students of SAMS & Non-SAMS HSS are advised to apply online by accessing <https://scholarship.odisha.gov.in/website/home>. Only online application under the scheme will be accepted and no request for accepting OFFLINE applications will be entertained. While applying online, students should upload the scanned copies of relevant documents.
- Students already availing scholarship under any other scheme of the state Govt are not eligible to avail this scholarship.
- Applicants are advised to be very careful to mention the accurate Bank Account related information in the specified box of the online application. In case of any wrong entry or mismatch of the SB Account, IFSC & MICR, the Government will not be held responsible for miscredit/ No credit.
- Incomplete or wrongly filled up application or application without essential documents shall be summarily rejected.
